## Sub: - Resumption of offline classes (Lab based) in NIFT Delhi Campus

This is to inform all concerned that as per directions issued by NIFT Head Office vide OM No.1312 (620)/Admin/HO/Request from Various campuses/2021 Dated 27th Aug 2021 and Order no F.60/DDMA/Covid-19/2021/463 dated 30<sup>th</sup> August 2021 issued by Delhi Disaster Management Authority, it has been decided that all students of NIFT Delhi (Regular, CE programs & PhD) are allowed to attend lab based classes at 50% of seating capacity in the campus wef. 01<sup>st</sup> September 2021. These lab based classes shall be held in hybrid mode (both offline and online). Students willing to attend offline lab based classes shall be required to submit a consent form, as applicable, from their parents to their respective Course Coordinators before being allowed to attend the classes.

In due course, the theory classes shall also be conducted in hybrid mode (both offline & online) with maximum fifty percent of seating capacity of the classroom.

The students are also required to follow COVID 19 guidelines attached with this circular.

The hostel shall remain closed till further orders.

## Guidelines for students attending offline classes in NIFT Delhi w.e.f 01st Sept 2021

- 1) All students will be required to undergo a temperature check at both entrances of the institute and undergo sanitization of their hands; only asymptomatic students will be allowed entry.
- 2) Those students who are found symptomatic will not be permitted entry to the campus. They are required to visit the nearest hospital for clinical advice.
- 3) All students are advised to get vaccinated at the earliest.
- 4) Students living in containment zones are not allowed to attend offline classes.
- 5) Students are required to maintain social distancing while they are in campus. They must avoid any gatherings during lunch or any other activities.
- 6) They are required to wear masks at all times. Any student not wearing a mask in the campus will be subject to disciplinary action and fines as per Government norms.
- 7) Students are required to carry their own sanitizers. However extra sanitizers would be made available at appropriate places in the campus.
- 8) Respiratory etiquettes should be followed and spitting is strictly prohibited.
- 9) If any student is diagnosed as COVID positive, he/she must immediately report the same to the respective Centre Coordinator and also give details of students/faculty/staff who had been in close proximity to them prior to diagnosis. Such COVID positive students will be allowed to attend physical classes only after producing COVID negative report.
- 10) Any student who has anxiety/stress issues may contact the Visiting Counselor of the Institute for seeking advice.
- 11) Extracurricular activities are not allowed where social distancing is not possible. All such activities will take place online till further orders.
- 12) Food kiosks will be made operational in phases. However students must avoid gathering at such places and maintain social distancing.
- 13) Sharing of books, other learning material and eatables is to be avoided.
- 14) Arogya setu app is to be downloaded by all students.
- 15) Resource Centre: Students of each department will be allotted slots in which they can access the Resource Centre so that social distancing is maintained. Access to the Resource Centre will be regulated by the guidelines framed by Head-Resource Centre which shall be published separately.
- 16) A squad of officials will monitor compliance of the above guidelines and the students in violation of the guidelines shall be liable for disciplinary action and penalties.
