### Common Lapses in Purchase & Contract Management

- Gaps in the technical specifications in the tender due to no Pre-bid consultation/market survey
- Advertisements in newspapers with limited reach.
- Inadequate time period for filing tenders.
- Splitting of work /supply order of similar nature.
- Relaxation in technical specifications during evaluation.
- Negotiations with L-1 in contravention of CVC Guidelines dated 3/3/2007.
- Absence of agreements
- All conditions of tenders are not being quoted or sometime new conditions are being introduced in the Agreements.
- Tender are floated for a term beyond authorized one, without the approval of the Competent Authority.
- Agreements are extended beyond Contract period without approval of the Competent Authority.
- Purchases in violation of Purchase Policy.
