IMPORTANT NOTE

1. Following are the Qualifying Criteria

1. The registered company, firm or an agency should have preferably two years experience similar type of works in the Educational institution / Government undertakings / Pvt. Sector organization.
2. The tenderer should have been registered with the competent authority and should have PAN & TAN number, GST registration, Registration of the Agency under the Shops & Establishment Act, PF registration with the Regional PF Commissioner, Workmen's Compensation Policy should have been taken if applicable.
3. The tenderer should not have been blacklisted by any organization.
4. In deciding upon the Selection of bidders for the work, great emphasis will be put on the ability reputation, experience for similar type of work done, financial standing, technical competency of bidders to provide quality services according to the time schedule.



5. The Agency must have a fleet of at least One bus of 40seat and above, duly registered at RTO in the Agency's name. Also the Transport Agency must be located at Gandhinagar / Ahmedabad for operational efficiency. Both these conditions are mandatory.
6. The average turnover of any one year among the last three (2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19) years should not be less than Rs.12 lakh (Rs. Twelve lakh) under the tender enquiry.
7. The bidder should be registered with GST.

\* *The tenderers shall comply with the requirements under qualifying criteria. Proofs shall be attached with abstract in separate sealed cover of Technical Bid, failing which will disqualify for opening of price bid cover.*

2. The tenderer should invariably submit his tender in three sealed covers separately namely; 1) EMD cover 2) Technical Bid cover and 3) Price Bid cover.

#### 2.1 EMD COVER

- i. EMD cover should contain EMD in form of Demand Draft or Banker cheque as mentioned on PTF. Offer without separate EMD cover, the technical bid will not be opened. THIS MAY PLEASE BE NOTED.

#### 3. TECHNICAL BID COVER

- i. Technical Bid cover should contain original copy of priced Tender Form (except commercial bid documents) along with attested copies of VAT and CST Registration certificate, copy of latest ITR filed with IT department, other certified documents as per check list.
- i. The average turnover of any one year among the last three years should not be less than Rs.12 lakh (Rs. Twelve lakh) under the tender enquiry. Duly certified audited copies of balance sheet tax assessment may be furnished.
- iii. The tenderer should also furnish the details of nature of their firm, names and addresses of the partners / proprietors / Directors and also the details of sister concerns, if any, with specific details or documents requested in Tender Enquiry.

In absence of these information/documents, tender is liable to be rejected.

#### 4. PRICE BID COVER

- i. Price Bid cover should contain only rates / prices of items.
  - ii. In case the tenderer fails to provide taxation details in its quotation, offers will be considered as inclusive of all taxes.
5. No correspondence will be entertained after opening of technical bids.

6. EMD of Rs. 7,500/- (Seven Thousand Five hundred) is required to be paid as per terms and conditions



of this tender enquiry. Tender without pre-payment of EMD will be out rightly rejected which may please be noted.

N.B.

The rates should be quoted both in words as well as in figure also. GST should be clearly stated with their percentages.

#### A. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Tenders for Bus Transport services shall be received on or before the last date/time indicated above (either by hand delivery or by registered post). Tender form for Bus Transport Services at NIFT contain 2 parts: (a) Technical Bids to ascertain the capability of Tendering parties, and (b) Commercial Bid indicating the rates for transport services. Technical bid shall be opened on the same day, in the presence of the tendering parties. The commercial bid of qualified bidders shall be opened at a later date after scrutiny of technical bids.
2. Tender letter should be addressed to the OSD, Gandhinagar by designation only and submitted at the address mentioned above in sealed covers, superscribed "Tender for Bus Transport services".
3. Tenders received after the specified date and time, due to whatsoever reason including postal delays, will not be considered.
4. Any conditional offers made by the Agency or any alterations/corrections made in the tender form shall not be considered. Similarly, incomplete and unsigned tender is liable to be rejected.
5. NIFT reserves the right to accept or reject any tender in part or full thereof without assigning any reason therefore.
6. The rates quoted by the Agency should be the lowest possible for the scope of work indicated. Any discounts offered, or any other charges that are leviable should be clearly mentioned in the forwarding letter.
7. The tender submitted by the Agency should remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of tenders.
8. The Agency submitting tender must enclose List of clients, with contact person's name and phone numbers and all other document required to be submitted along with the tender.
9. No interest shall be paid on the said EMD and will be returned after finalization of the tender; however, the EMD of the successful bidder will converted to Security Deposit.
10. In the following events EMD may forfeited:
  - a. If information declared/document submitted found false/fake/forged
  - b. If the selected/successful bidder does not accept the W.O., or, unable to provide services. / Refuses to undertake work for any reason.
  - c. If the bidder withdraws his bid/quote during tender process.



11. The EMD will be refunded to unsuccessful tenderers after two months or completion tender process whichever is earlier and no interest shall accrue on this deposit.
12. Tender form is non-transferable and can be used only by the party in whose name it has been issued by NIFT.
13. The schedule issued with the form of tender listing the services to be rendered must not be altered by the tenderer. Any modifications/alterations of the schedule considered necessary by the tenderer, should be in the separate letter accompanying the tender.
14. No paper shall be detached from the tender:
15. The tender is liable to be ignored if complete information is not given there-in, or, if the particulars and data (if any) asked for in the schedule to the tender are not filled in, or any part is altered and so forth.
16. Individual signing the tender or other documents connected with the tender must specify whether he signs as
  - (i) A sole proprietor of the concern or constituted attorney of such sole proprietor.
  - (ii) A partner of the firm if it is a partnership, in which case he must have authority to execute contracts on behalf of the firm and refer to arbitration disputes concerning the business of the partnership either by virtue of the partnership agreement or by a power of attorney duly executed by the partners of the firm.
  - (iii) Director or Principal Officer duly authorised by the Board of Directors of the company.
  - (iv) In case of (ii) a copy of the partnership agreement or general power of Attorney, in either case attested by a Notary Public should be furnished or an affidavit on stamp paper duly sworn or affirmed by all the partners admitting execution of the partnership agreement or the general power of attorney should be furnished. The attested copy of the certificate of registration of power of attorney should be attached alongwith the tender papers. In case of partnership, where no authority to refer dispute concerning the business of the partnership has been conferred on any partner, the tender and all other related documents must be signed by all the partners of the firm. In case of (iii) the person signing the tender should be authorised by a resolution passed by the Board of Directors and a copy of the resolution attested by the Principal Officer should be attached.
17. Lowest rate of "Trip up to 80 kms / 4 hrs" of Commercial Bid will be considered for deciding L1 agency.
18. The employees of the Contractor should possess sound health and be free from any diseases, especially contagious and frequently recurring diseases and they should be in uniform while on duty.
19. The tenderer is to be signed in every page of tender documents.
20. NIFT shall in no way be responsible for any default with regard to any statutory obligation and the Contractor will indemnify NIFT in case of any damage or liability, which may arise on account of action of contractor.



21. The agency shall not engage the services of any subcontractor or transfer the contract to any other person.
22. The contractor shall be responsible to provide bus Services without any obstacle and within 30 minutes of call.
23. NIFT shall in no way be responsible for any default with regard to any statutory obligation and the firm will indemnify NIFT in case of any damage or liability, which may arise on account of action of firm.
24. Any dispute arising with regards to any aspect of this agreement shall be resolved by mutual discussions and consultations between the parties to the Agreement. In Case, the dispute remains unresolved through consultation, it shall be referred to an Arbitrator, to be appointed in consultation by the two parties involved in the dispute, as per provisions governing Arbitration Act of the country.
25. The contractor shall at all times indemnify and keep indemnified the owner and its officers, servants and agents for and against all third party claims whatsoever (including claim not limited to property loss and damage, personal accident, injury or death of/ or property or person of any sub-contract and or the servants or agents of the Firm any sub-firm(s) and or the owner and the Firm shall at his own cost and initiative at all times, maintain all liabilities under Workman's Compensation Act/Fatal Accident Act, Personal Injuries, Insurance Act and/or their Industrial Legislation from time to time in force.
26. Firms submitting tender would be considered to have read & accepted all terms & conditions. No enquiries, verbal or written shall be entertained in respect of acceptance or rejection of the tender.
27. The financial bid/s will be opened only for those tenderers whose technical bids are qualified.
28. The vehicles should be in excellent conditions, Parking charges at Airports/Parking lots and toll fees will be borne by NIFT on production of original bills/slips.
29. All Challans/Transport Authority payments will be borne by the contractor.
30. Any attempt at negotiation direct or indirect on the part of a tenderer with the authority to whom he has submitted the tender or the authority who is competent finally to accept it after he has submitted his tender or any endeavor to secure any interest for an actual or prospective tenderer or to influence by any means the acceptance of a particular tender will render the tender liable to exclusion from consideration.
31. Service Provider shall not engage any person below 18 years of age.
32. Vehicles should be fitted with necessary accessories to drive on State and National highways including during the nights. Fog lights are to be fitted.
33. Vehicles should also be fitted with Towing hook.
34. Contractor shall obtain vehicle fitness certificate from the Competent Authority, vehicle registration, comprehensive insurance, payment of road tax, inter-state permit, etc.





35. Contractor shall ensure that the driver has valid driving license.
36. Vehicle should be able to move freely to the neighboring States without any restrictions.
37. Contractor shall provide valid certificate of pollution check for the vehicle from the concerned authorities from time to time and the same shall be renewed well before the due date.
38. All vehicles shall be comprehensively insured against all risks (including the driver and occupants & third party). Insurance policy shall be renewed well before the due date.
39. All repairs and maintenance, running costs, fuel, lubricants, salaries of drivers, taxes, etc. will be borne by the contractor.
40. All drivers shall have valid driving license and proof of the same shall be provided by the Contractor.
41. Contractor shall not deploy any vehicle running on LPG/CNG.
42. The applicant should not assign this contract or any part thereof to any third party.
43. Driver should always carry all necessary documents like Registration papers, Insurance papers, Pollution Under Control (PUC) clearance, RTO tax payment papers, valid driving license (original) and all other documents that should be carried with vehicle as per rules & regulations of applicable laws.
44. In case of any accident to the vehicle, it will be the responsibility of the contractor or his representative (drivers) to lodge FIR etc. with police. All RTO issues and traffic violations are to be taken care by the contractor.
45. The contract is valid for providing services of vehicle hiring and at no point of time any or all of the Staff of Transporter shall raise a claim for employment in the NIFT – Gandhinagar
46. Drivers should carry sufficient cash for discharging obligations on account of parking charges & toll taxes. Parking charges & toll fee will be reimbursed, upon the submission of documents along with such claims.
47. Lodging, boarding, transportation of drivers shall be the contractor's responsibility.
48. Driver should be alert /careful enough to take care of items/material kept in the vehicles.
49. Vehicle should carry portable fire extinguisher.
50. Driver should be in possession of valid driving license issued by RTO for the class of vehicle he is driving.
51. Driver should wear uniform which should be properly washed / ironed (Not Colorful).



52. Driver should be able to read and write English, Gujarati and Hindi and have minimum three years of experience.
53. Driver should not smoke or drink; chew Pan/Pan masala/Tobacco inside the car both while driving or otherwise.
54. Should be in possession of Mobile phone and should not use mobile phone, while driving.
55. The age of the driver should be between 18 – 40 years.

## B. LEGAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Contractor and his staff must abide by various rules and regulations of NIFT including safety precautions, as prevalent from time to time.
2. The Contractor shall comply with all existing applicable labour legislations and Acts, such as Contract Labour Regulation Act, Workmens' Compensation Act, Minimum Wages Act, The Payment of Wages Act, Provident Fund Act, The Payment of Bonus Act etc. For any lapse or breach on the part of the Contractor in respect of non-compliance of any Labour legislations in force during the validity of the contract, the Contractor shall be fully responsible and would indemnify the Institute, in case the Institute is held liable for the lapse on the part of the Contractor.
3. The Contractor shall submit to NIFT, a list of drivers and conductors engaged to carry out the contract work, indicating name, age, home address, qualifications, etc, and would also intimate as and when any change takes place. The Contractor shall not at any time engage any minor and having not valid driving licenses to carry out the work under the contract.
4. The Contractor shall undertake that any act of omission or commission including theft, by his staff shall be his sole responsibility and further that he would compensate the Institute immediately, any loss or damage or theft occurring on account of his staff individually or collectively.
5. NIFT reserves the right to terminate the contract without prior notice at any time before the expiry of the term, in case the work performance is not upto the standard, or in case, there is any violation of NIFT rules & regulations, or if there is any lapse in compliance of any applicable labour legislations, or if there, is any incident of indiscipline on the part of the Contractor or his staff. The decision of NIFT's management in this regard would be final and binding on the Contractor. In such an event, NIFT shall have the right to engage any other contractor to carry out the task at his risk and on his account without obtaining any written consent from the tenderer.
6. However, either party may opt to terminate the contract at Three month's notice, without assigning any reason for doing so.
7. The Contractor and his staff shall comply with all instructions and directions of the NIFT authorities given from time to time. In the event of any emergent situation, the staff of the Contractor shall comply with instructions given by the NIFT authorities, without waiting for confirmation by the Contractor.



8. The contract shall be valid initially for a period of one year only from the date of award of the contract. The contract could be renewed / extended further for two year on mutually agreed terms, depending upon satisfactory services of the Contractor.
9. All the drivers and conductors engaged by the Contractor for carrying out tasks under this contract, shall be deemed to be the employees of the Contractor's Agency. The Agency shall be solely responsible for their wages, fringe benefits, conduct, duty roster, leave-records, relievers, etc. The Agency shall also provide its Workers photo-identity cards which shall be checked by the Security supervisor as and when necessary.
10. Non compliance of any terms and conditions enumerated in the contract shall be treated as a breach of contract.

### C. FINANCIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. NIFT will pay to the contractor, the amount every month as per actual transport services rendered, normally within 20 working days, on raising pre-receipted bill in duplicate, duly certified by the NIFT transport incharge.
2. Revision of Bus Transport rates per trip, shall be considered by NIFT only when diesel rates increase or decrease by 5% at a time per liter and the revised proportionate rates shall be effective from 1<sup>st</sup> day of the following month, in which such diesel rates gets changed.
3. For calculation of rates for diesel consumption, the Agency must provide break up of its quotation between: (a) fuel cost per round trip of bus running, and (b) other costs such as wages, maintenance, taxes, agency charges etc.
4. Any changes in the Minimum Wages Act, or in any other labour legislations or other statutory obligations during the validity period of the contract shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.
5. Income tax, GST, Service tax etc. as per prevalent laws, shall be deducted at source while making payment of Contractor's bills.
6. A sum of **Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only)** would be deposited with NIFT by the Contractor, in the form of non-interest bearing security. This amount of security deposit shall be refunded on completion of the contract.

### D. SCOPE OF WORK AND SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: BUS TRANSPORT SERVICES CONTRACT

1. The Agency must have a fleet of at least one bus of 40 seat and above, duly registered at RTO in the Agency's name. Also the Transport Agency must be located at Gandhinagar / Ahmedabad for operational efficiency. Both these conditions are mandatory.
2. The transportation services (40-43 seat buses) will be required as per schedule. The institute may make necessary changes in timings, schedules, days, trips etc. as per requirement, from time to time.



3. The Agency shall provide buses with required seats capacity for local and out of stations trips as and when required by NIFT, at schedule rates during the contract period.
4. The Contractor will be fully responsible for the drivers, conductors, petrol-diesel, maintenance, RTO permits, insurance etc.
5. The vehicle should be insured fully including third party insurance.
6. The vehicles must be in excellent/good working condition, and will have to be serviced at regular intervals and be kept neat and clean every day.
7. Monthly payment will be done on the basis of signed/certified log book. On production and certification of bills, payments will be made within twenty working days.
8. In case of failure of vehicle or non availability of the vehicle for any reason, the contractor will have to arrange for the substitute vehicle of similar kind. If the institute arranges for the substitute vehicle, the hire charges paid by the institute will be deducted from the monthly bill, along with a penalty charge of Rs. 500/- on each such occasion.
9. The vehicles shall be provided seven days a week. In case of exigencies, the contractor will also provide for extra trips.
10. The Transport Agency shall submit a copy of vehicle's registration book, fitness certificate, and copy of Insurance policy etc. to NIFT.
11. Vehicles may be used for the Inter State travels, if required.
