- 9. ISO 9001: The oldger or the OEM of the offered products must have ISO 9001 certification.
- 10. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. - 13. Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.
