A single merit list shall be drawn of all applications received from campuses against available seats by taking merit into account at HO. The last date of filling the online application by students in CMS is 5th March 2018.

All the CI&DL's are requested to kindly facilitate maximum student entries from their respective Centres.

Short listing of candidates for sending to the foreign university shall be done by SIAC-I&DL at HO. The eligibility and selection criteria for selection of students shall be the same as being followed for summer programme.

As per the policy in the Academic Manual (pg-212) students applying for exchange programme shall submit a security deposit of Rs. 15,000/- through a PDC (dated 04.04.2013) in favor of NIFT.
