Term& conditions:-

- The rate quoted must be inclusive of all taxes and F.O.R. NIFT Office premises. These rates will be valid till the contract period.
- The frequency of supply of water at the location will be met with daily requirement which is 35,000 liters to 45,000 liters approximately (or) as per the requirement by the NIFT Bengaluru.
- The quantities as mentioned above are approximate and may vary on need basis.
- The water should be bore / open well water.
- Water should be clear, potable, totally hygienic, odorless, and equivalent to municipal standards for drinking use.
- Supplier shall submit the test reports of water, (Chemical & Biological) to NIFT, Bengaluru, on monthly basis as required from an approved laboratory and the expenses of tests should be borne by the supplier only.
- The tanker/container used for supplying water should be clean and in satisfactory hygienic condition.
- Bill should be raised on monthly basis. Along with the attached delivery challan for proof of delivery Necessary payment shall be released after checking all the necessary documents along with Claim bill.
- Rs.5000/- will be charged if water is not supplied for consecutive 02 (Two) days.
- Security Deposit shall be forfeited if water is not supplied for consecutive 10 (Ten) days.
- If the quality of water supplied is found to be contaminated or not as per drinking standards, the security deposit of the supplier may be forfeited and the contract will be terminated & legal action will be taken against the supplier. Penalty shall be recoverable from the bills of the contractor and / or by adjustment from the security deposit at the discretion of the NIFT, Bengaluru.
- Service provider has to deposit an amount of **Rs.20,000/-** as security deposit within 02 days on receipt of work order. Else while same may be adjusted from the first month bill.
- The contract period will be for four month or end of the semester 2024 whichever is earlier.
