Girls Hostel: Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: What are the accommodation options available for students at NIFT Gandhinagar?

A1: NIFT Gandhinagar offers well-equipped girls' hostels on twin sharing basis/ double occupancy rooms. NIFT Gandhinagar does not provide hostel accommodation for boys. A very limited single room facility is available on medical grounds or as deemed necessary and approved by the competent authority.

Q2: What is the process for applying to the girls' hostel?

A2: First year girls students can apply for hostel accommodation during the admission process. Detailed hostel booking/allotment process information, instructions and application forms are available on the NIFT Gandhinagar official website. Q3: Is hostel accommodation guaranteed for all female students?

A3: While NIFT Gandhinagar aims to accommodate as many students as possible, hostel allocation is subject to availability and is done on a first-come, first-served basis. Hostel will be allotted to First-year Girls students of UG and PG, SPT and NLEA students. Students other than mentioned can apply, but the allotment will be done as per the available vacancies and after due approval of the competent authority.

Q4: Whether applicant will have any say while selecting the room and roommates?

A4: As per the hostel policy, rooms will be allotted on first come first serve basis via chit based system or any other systems as per the instructions of the competent authority, so no preferences of room, location and roommates will be entertained.

Q5: What is the fee structure for hostel accommodation?

A5: The fee structure is detailed on the NIFT Gandhinagar website and includes charges for accommodation. **The mentioned fee is for the entire academic year as per the academic calendar.**

Q6: Are there A/C and Non A/C rooms for hostellers?

A6: There are only Non A/C rooms for hostellers. However, NIFT Gandhinagar permits the use of Air Coolers in the rooms. Students can apply for the permission of keeping air coolers through Hostel Warden. Students will have to bear the per month fixed electricity charges.

Q7: What basic infrastructure has been provided to the hostellers?

A7: The Hostel rooms (double occupancy) have been provided with two cots, in-built almirahs with mirror, two sets of table-chair and two book racks.

Q8: What is the important stuff we have to bring?

A8: Bring your recent passport-size colored pictures, original documents, and other stationery items. The hostellers should bring Single Bed Mattress, pillows, bedsheets, pillow covers, blanket, lock and key (2), mirror, bucket, mug, toiletries, dustbin, broom, dust pan and other essential items as deemed appropriate. The same could be purchased from the nearby market, especially those coming from distant places.

Q9: What facilities are available in the girls' hostel?

A9: The Hostel has two big common rooms having facilities like TV, Microwave, Induction plate, resting/ yoga space for residents and iron with ironing board. A small amphitheater is attached to the Hostel for informal activities.

Q10: What about the cleanliness of the hostel room?

A10: The room's cleanliness is the student's sole responsibility. The student has to maintain the room's hygiene and keep the room's belongings in order. The housekeeping staff will clean the corridor, washrooms, and other common areas.

Q11: Do you have attached toilets in the hostel rooms?

A11: No, hostel has a shared bath blocks on each floor. Geysers are provided in these blocks to be used during the winter season. The blocks are equipped with western commodes, bathrooms, washbasins, incinerators for disposal of sanitary pads and sanitary vending machine.

Q12: Does hostel provide laundry facility?

Ans12: The hostel does not offer laundry services or provide washing machines for resident use. There are designated areas where washed clothes can be dried. There are several nearby laundromats and laundry service providers that offer convenient and affordable options. Students can contract them for laundry services.

Q13: What measures are in place to ensure the safety and security of students in the hostel?

A13: The hostel is equipped with 24/7 security, CCTV surveillance, and strict entry and exit protocols. There is also a resident warden and lady security staff available.

Q14: Are there any regulations of timings for the hostellers?

A14: Yes, there is a regulation of timings to ensure the safety of all residents. All the residents report **LATEST BY 10.15 PM to the hostel**. No resident may remain outside the hostel after 10:15 p.m. Gates once locked will not be opened. **There is no provision for late night entry permission beyond the stipulated time in the hostel**. Any late entry and unauthorized absence in the night will amount to an act of indiscipline and is liable to be expelled without any warning.

Q15: In the guidelines mentioned in the hostel resident brochure and hostel admission form, you request to submit information regarding one local guardian. But what if we do not have any local guardian in Gandhinagar or in nearby place.

A15: Nomination of Local Guardian is recommended for the allotment of Hostel Seat. This enables a timely emergency response, if required. In case of unavailability of LG within Gandhinagar or Ahmedabad or nearby places, please provide emergency contact details.

Q16: What are the dining arrangements in the hostel?

A16: There is no exclusive dining facility within the hostel. However, Campus has a full-fledged mess facility for the students staying in the hostel which can be accessed by paying mess charges separately to the Institute.

Q17: What healthcare facilities are available for hostel residents?

A17: The hostel has a medical room with a visiting doctor for a stipulated time. For more serious medical issues, students are assisted to nearby hospitals.

Q18: Are there any specific rules and regulations that hostel residents need to follow?

A18: Yes, residents must adhere to the hostel rules and regulations which include maintaining cleanliness, following timings, procedure to avail leave from the hostel and respecting the rights and privacy of fellow residents. Detailed rules are provided in Girls HOSTEL RESIDENT'S

Q19: What is the procedure for reporting grievances or issues in the hostel?

A19: Students can report grievances or issues directly to the hostel warden. Concerns should be communicated to both hostel representatives and the warden, who will take the necessary steps to resolve them. Additionally, there is a formal grievance redressal mechanism to ensure timely resolution of complaints. A complaint register is maintained at the hostel reception for students to log their concerns.

Q20: Can hostel residents have visitors?

A20: Yes, residents can have only female visitors during specified visiting hours. Visitors must register at the hostel security and are not allowed beyond the reception area.

Q21: What is the procedure of applying for the leave from the hostel?

A21: Students are allowed to leave the hostel on weekends and holidays, but they must take permission from the hostel warden and sign out and in upon departure and return for safety reasons. Also, leave sanctioned for absence from the Institute does not mean leave from the Hostel. Absence from the Hostel for one or more nights must be approved by the Hostel Warden. For any absence from the hostel permission has to be taken one day in advance in the prescribed format (available with Hostel warden) with Self- Attested Photocopy of the I-Card by the girl student. The acknowledgement of the letter will be given by the warden by signing on the permissions. The absence permission will be given after receiving a written request of the parents/local guardian submitted via respective id's as recorded in the application form. The request must be submitted to hostel-warden one day before the absence request date.
