The following amendment may be noted in the terms & conditions of tender document:-

Also, the said mode of payment is subject to change depending on NIFT policy.

Agency should quote rate considering the same.	It may be noted that the students remain away from the Hostel during breaks in June-July, end December, beginning of the year, during festive seasons (Dussera/Diwali, etc.). During the break in June-July the contractor need not to pay the maintenance charges; however, he should vacate the canteen premises and the canteen should not be operational during June-July. Agency should quote rate considering the same as no payment will be made to the contractor during the break period of June-July.

The other terms and conditions prescribed in the tender document remain unchanged.
